One2One -Israel-World Jewry Teen Encounters

- ENTER's One2One is proud to have concluded the 2024–2025 school year with over 3,500 participants.
- In total, the program has officially reached over 12,000 participants since inception!
- Over the past year, ENTER has worked with 91 teachers from 48 schools in Israel. Teens from outside of Israel came to One2One from 71 international organizations from the following countries: Argentina, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Mexico, Panama, South Africa, Switzerland, United Kingdom, United States.
- We continue to deepen our partnership with RootOne by providing One2One as a pre-trip experience as well as incentives for alumni and additional teens.





One2One -Israel-World Jewry Teen Encounters

- We are now partnering with Mosaic United to provide One2One as a pre-trip offering for teens traveling to Israel from the United Kingdom, Mexico, and South America.
- We are excited to expand our partnership with the Israeli Ministry of Education by offering a One2One Spanish-language track. Israeli teens studying Spanish were matched with Spanish-speaking teens from Mexico, Panama, Peru and Chile.
- Highlights from the forthcoming One2One 2025 Evaluation Report:
 - 96% of the teens reported that they enjoyed the meetings;
 - 87% of the non-Israeli teens are more confident speaking about Israel:
 - 76% of the Israelis at the end of the program reported feeling connected to Jews living abroad.





ENTER Supporting One2One Teens During Israel-Iran War

At the beginning of the 12-day war with Iran, One2One reached out to current and past participants with the following message:

One2One was founded on the concept that the Jewish people are deeply connected, no matter the distance between us. This is an opportunity to strengthen this sense of togetherness by reaching out to your partners to ask how they are doing, share what you are experiencing and to remind one another that we are not alone.

Many participants have been in contact with their partners and have indicated how moved they have been by the support they received.



Peoplehood Infused Schools

- Last May, ENTER partnered with the Ministry of Education and schools in the U.S. and Israel to organize a social-educational Hackathon focused on Jewish Peoplehood and Shavuot. The students created a Shavuot basket using Jewish values of their choosing. ENTER wrote the formal curriculum for the day, which the Ministry of Education has since adopted to be shared with other cities for future events.
- During Israel's National Memorial Day, Yom Hazikaron, nine schools from ENTER's Peoplehood Infused Schools program learned about stories of Lone Soldiers and their presentations were incorporated into the schools' ceremonies.





ENTER Supporting Peoplehood Infused Schools during Israel-Iran War

- During the outbreak of the Israel-Iran War, ENTER has been connecting communities across the world, inviting those outside of Israel to send messages of solidarity to Israeli elementary schools and faculty. In addition, ENTER has provided the education staff in Israel with content and tools to help them through this difficult period.
- ENTER created an interactive website that teachers can access as an educational tool for remote learning, conveying the messages of support from abroad.










